- 1. <u>Call to order and introductions of visitors</u> Kathlene Shank called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm

- 5. Administrative Reports
 - a. President

The subcommittee met. Dr. Glassman reported that he testified before the Senate regarding the budget impasse and the effects on EIU, and there was another Senate hearing regarding the retooling and repositioning of EIU and the U of I Compact. Dr. Glassman is scheduled to testify before the House next week, and he will continue to advocate for higher education. He mentioned actions other universities

are taking. Dr. Glassman also provided an update on interim and vacant administrative positions.

b. Interim Vice President for Business Affairs

The subcommittee met and reviewed February financial statements. Paul McCann is projecting to be under budget at yearend. He presented before the House committee regarding administrative cost, and all other universities will appear before the House committee as well. EIU's response is that administrative costs went down depending on the definition.

c. Interim Vice President for Student Affairs

Lynette Drake reported the subcommittee met and reviewed budgets. Currently there is a trial period on parking changes for undergraduate students. Student Affairs continues to look at mobile apps for the campus. Ms. Drake announced that the last vacant position in the University Police Department has been filled.
