 - a. Why does it matter?
 - Trans students are exposed to being misgendered or deadnamed. They also experience language that excludes them as well as inaction from bystanders.
 - They identify us. Pronouns connect us with others on a personal level. When our pronouns are used correctly, we feel respected.
 - b. How to Ask:
 - i. Simply ask "What are your pronouns?"
 - ii. Introducing yourself with your pronouns.
 - iii. **Special note:** some people may choose to not share their pronouns. Do not force them to share!
 - c. When you get pronouns incorrect:
 - i. What to do: say "sorry" and correct yourself.
 - ii. What not to do: make a big deal of it and shift attention on yourself.
 - d. What You Can Do:
 - i. Share pronouns in an email signature
 - ii. Use one's pronouns when they're shared with you!
 - iii. Know the locations of all-gender restrooms on campus/ workspace
 - iv. Use and encourage inclusive language
