#### Can membership in SHRM help me find a job after graduation?

Yes. Job search books and placement studies all agree that 60%–70% of jobs are found through personal contacts or networking. #### What is my chapter number?

If no chapter exists on your campus, write "5000" in the chapter number space and obtain the signature of your academic advisor or other school official who can verify your student status. #### **Application Procedure**

- Complete the student membership application in its entirety. Special attention should be given to all fields which are designated "required."
- You must attach a copy of your current course schedule. Please staple this to your application, as we cannot process your membership without it. This is verification of your student status.
- Be sure to have your advisor sign your application.
- Don't forget to include payment for your membership.
- Mail or fax your membership application to the address listed on the application.
- Please allow 4–6 weeks for processing of mailed applications that include payment by check or money order. If faxing your application with credit card payment, processing time will be substantially decreased.
