

Running the Transfer Evaluation Audit

A "Transfer Evaluation" audit allows you to see how coursework will transfer EIU.

1. To run a "Transfer Evaluation" audit, click the "What-If?" button.

2. Select the appropriate information from the drop-down menus:

- The college or school should be "Interdisciplinary."
- The degree should be "Undeclared."
- The major should be "Transfer Evaluation Audit Only" (to view your courses and determine how they will transfer to EIU), OR you can select "Transfer Progress Audit Only" (to determine how your courses will meet EIU's general education requirements.)
- The appropriate catalog year and term. Keep in mind that requirements may vary, depending on the year/term selected.
- The minor should be "No minor."

3. Now click "Run Analysis."
