Sogang University strives to promote academic exchanges with institutions around the world. Learn about one of the "four tigers" of Asia firsthand.

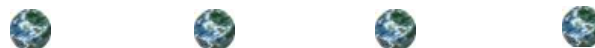
United Kingdom
