The University Foundations Advisory Committee is seeking Eastern students who will be **juniors or seniors** Fall 2012 to apply to be peer leaders for the freshman seminar course, EIU 1111: University Foundations. Peer Leaders will be paired with an instructor and will assist the instructor with the teaching of the class, including leading class discussion, creating activities, working in groups, and the citizenship activity. Employment from August 15, 2012-December 14, 2012.

This is an excellent opportunity to work with freshman college students to serve as a role model and mentor and to gain classroom and leadership experience. Peer leaders will be hired as student employees for Fall 2012 and will receive a **\$500 stipend** for the semester to be paid in 8 installments throughout the semester. **Mandatory training** will take place on May 4, 2012 and August 15, 2012.
