The Lumpkin College of Business and Applied Sciences Curriculum Committee recently approved the following changes in the Career and Technical Education (Business Ed Emphasis) program, effective Fall 2004 (see attachments):

1. Remove the CIS 2000, 3200, or 3530 option because students receive some of the content in other courses and other content is not necessary.
2. Remove BUS 3710 requirement because it is no longer needed.
3. Include in the 36-hour Business Education requirements:
  - a. BUS 2750 – Legal and Social Environment of Business
  - b. BUS 3010 – Management and Organizational Behavior
  - c. BUS 3470 – Principles of Marketing
