01-24. New Course Proposal – Chemistry 3300. Survey of Biochemistry. (3-0-3) F, S.

IV. Executive Action

The following was approved by executive action to be effective Fall 2002:

1. CHM 2430 -- Change course credits, course offering, and course description to read as follows: “Survey of Organic Chemistry. (3-0-3) F,S. A survey of organic compounds organized by the principal functional groups. Structure, properties, reactions, and mechanisms are included. Prerequisite: CHM (1410, 1415) or (1510, 1515). Co-requisite: concurrent enrollment in CHM 2435. No credit toward the chemistry major or Track II of the chemistry minor or for students with prior credit in CHM 2440. **EGR 963**”
2. CHM 2310 – Change course title, course credits, and course description to read as follows: “Inorganic Chemistry. (3-0-3) S. Physical and chemical properties of the elements and their compounds; basic coordination chemistry; properties of solids. Prerequisites: CHM (1410,1415) or (1510,1515).
3. Mathematics Department – Change name of the department to The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science.
4. GEG 3885 – Delete MAT 2250G as a prerequisite.
