# Psych Study Abroad

---

**What:** A four-week study abroad opportunity in Maastricht, the Netherlands. Multicultural Human Behavior is a class in cross-cultural psychology & sociology that offers students the opportunity to learn about the influence of culture on behavior. Course requirements include pre-departure readings, daily reading and writing assignments, two tests, a research paper, and a journal. The latter two are due on a date after return to the U.S. Typically two or three day-long field trips are part of the class.

**Where:** Maastricht, the oldest city in the Netherlands, is the capital of Limburg province and centrally located in the heart of western Europe. Maastricht (pop. 125,000) is full of beautiful old buildings and is an easy city to explore. It is also very safe. Students stay in the local hostel. The hostel is quite new and in a beautiful location on the bank of the Maas River. Sleeping rooms, the classroom, dining hall, and computer lab are all conveniently located in the same building.

**How much?** Although airfare can vary, the trip in the past has cost approximately \$4000 per student. This includes tuition for 6 hours of credit, room, board, and airfare. Students will be billed separately for airfare and the other course expenses.
