Burn all of the information onto a CD-R disk. Please check to make sure it opens on both DOS and MAC computers. Please make sure you put your name and address on the disk. You may, if you wish, send hard copies of all the materials just to be on the safe side. Please include them in a separate envelope, not to exceed 8.5"x11" in dimensions. Be sure to label this envelope with your name, too.

- IMAGES OF A MAQUETTE/MODEL OF THE PROPOSED SCULPTURE** Scale: 1"=1'0". Required: Front, left, right, back and top sides. Detail pictures as necessary. Additional sketches, technical drawings/CAD, or 3-D computer models allowed but will NOT be accepted in lieu of a model. 10 images maximum. 300 dpi, 6" x 9" jpegs.
- IMAGES OF PAST SCULPTURE WORKS** Please provide title, materials utilized, and dimensions plus the date of completion. 5-10 images. 300 dpi, 6 x 9" jpegs.
- LETTER OF SUPPORT** from your major sculpture professor. (MS Word Document)
- APPLICATION MATERIALS WILL NOT BE RETURNED.** Sculptors selected for a residency will have their application materials retained by the university. Applicants not selected will have their application materials properly disposed of at the end of the residency period.
