Presentation from Chris Dearth, Director of Admissions:

- His goal is more communication to more students, focusing on successful outcomes.
- The department is using direct mail, texts, and emails to communicate to students, along with social media such as Facebook and Twitter.
- The department plans to be "proactive" instead of "reactive" and more transparent.
- Fall inquiries are up as well as campus visits.
- At college fairs, they are getting feedback on road from high school counselors asking about EIU.
- New director is introducing himself to local schools.
- They are implementing on-site admission program which allows EIU to admit high school students on-the-spot, if eligible.
- Talking to families about affordability
- Suggestions were made about mailing "View Books" to juniors/seniors; using alumni
 volunteers to help recruitment; sending info to teaching EPS alums to post in their
 schools.

 - CUPB Budgets have been loaded; CUPB talking about changing their By-Laws; FY 15 attrition saved \$4.6 million; reduced positions from 1642 to 1562
