


Knowledge is Power.

The British Museum
Discovered by one of
Napoleon's officers during the
Egyptian campaign of 1799,
the hieroglyphs of the Rosetta
Stone were deciphered by
Jean-François Champollion.
He compared the figures to
the demotic and Greek scripts
also inscribed on the Rosetta,
and so uncovered the secrets
of the signs of ancient Egypt.




President Abdel Nasser visits the Unfinished Pyramid of Sekhemkhet at Saqqara with its excavator, Zakaria Ghoneim, 1954.

















