Carlotta Berry is an associate professor in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering at Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology where she also serves as director of the Multidisciplinary Minor in Robotics and co-director of the Rose Building Undergraduate Diversity Program.

She received her Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering from Vanderbilt University. Her research interests are in robotics education, interface design, human-robot interaction and increasing underrepresented populations in STEM fields.

She has taught undergraduate courses in Human-Robot Interaction and Mobile Robotics for several years and has been the president of the Technical Editor Board for the ASEE Computers in Education Journal since 2012. She has also been the secretary and treasurer in IEEE Central Indiana Section, IEEE Central Tennessee Section and ASEE Mind Division. She is a member of ASEE, IEEE, NSBE and Eta Kappa Nu.

She has been married to William Berry for 12 years and has one 8 year old daughter, Kennedy Amaya. She is also a judge for the FIRST Robotics Competition and co-leader of her daughter’s Daisy Girl Scout Troop.
