Thirty-Three 1-A Men and Five 1-B Men to Be Sent to Chicago for Induction Thursday, August 20

Thirty-three men classified as 1-A and five men classified as 1-B will be sent from Jasper county to the Chicago Induction station for examination and induction into the United States Army on Thursday, August 20. In addition, seven other men have previously enlisted in the Army and Navy, who would have been included in this group.

This is the largest group of men who have ever been sent from Jasper county at one time, and shows the Army's urgent need for men at this time. All those accepted for general combat duty are classified as 1-A, while those with minor physical defects are placed in 1-B and will be used for limited service in the United States.
