

Park Board Adds June 26, Twelve New Furnaces '1942 at Peterson Park

A dozen new furnaces have been placed in Peterson Park by the Park Board for the use of the public in grilling steaks, toasting wieners and doing other cooking for picnic dinners and suppers. With these added to the furnaces already in use, there should be enough to permit everyone who wants to use them to have one within a reasonable time.

They were built at the NYA Center shops at Oblong from an old smoke stack. This was cut into lengths and bars welded across the top, and then a hole for the flue cut in the side. The furnaces were then set in concrete so they will be solid.

With the tire shortage, the Park Board believes that many more people will use Peterson Park for recreation than ever before and has made this contribution to their enjoyment.
