## VIRGIL SHUMARD'S FUNERAL TODAY

Funeral services for Virgil Shumard will be held at the Central Christian church in Newton this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock and burial will be in Riverside cemetery. Jasper post, American Legion, will be in charge of the services at the grave and will act as a guard of honor.
