

DR. KENT WATTLEWORTH RESIGNS FROM T. B. BOARD

A special meeting was called at the office of Miss Madeline Groesch, county nurse, Tuesday by Mrs. Norma Eaton, secretary of the Jasper County Tuberculosis Board, to take care of necessary business before Dr. Kent Wattleworth left to report to the army.

\$500.00 was transferred from the tuberculosis fund to the nursing fund to help pay the salary of the nurse. It was decided to grant the secretary, Miss Emily Dhom, two weeks vacation a year, to be taken during the summer months when the county nurse will be on duty in the office. A motion was made by Dr. Wattleworth and seconded by Mrs. Eaton to pay for the rental on the telephone in the nurse's office.

At this meeting, Dr. Wattleworth tendered his resignation as a member of the board.
