GROUP OF THIRTY-NINE

Twelve of the thirty-nine men who went from Jasper county to the Chicago induction station of the United States Army last Wednesday were rejected. A group of eleven will be sent from Jasper county next week in the first call during November received by the local Selective Service Board.
