

FRANK MULVANEY DIES MONDAY AFTERNOON

Aug. 16, 1943

Frank Andrew Mulvaney died Monday afternoon at his home near Yale after an illness of about ten days. Death was due to uremic poisoning.

He was born in Jasper county January 14, 1875, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Mulvaney, and had always resided here. His death came just a month and a half after the death of his wife on June 1.

He leaves two sons and a daughter, Charles Mulvaney of Shelbyville, Seaman Wilbur Lorraine Mulvaney, United States Navy, Moscow, Idaho, and Lavelle at home; and five grandchildren.

He is also survived by a sister and three brothers, Mrs. Mary Bever of Newton, William A. Mulvaney of Detroit, Michigan, Fred Mulvaney of Baltimore, Maryland, and Joseph Mulvaney, address unknown; other relatives and many friends.

Funeral services will be held at 4:00 o'clock this afternoon at the Christian chapel at Falmouth, and burial will be in the nearby cemetery.
