Takes Course at Famous
Old Scotch University, 1943*

Headquarters, European Theatre of Operations, August 20.—Sergeant Delbert L. Blair, 26 years old, of Newton vicinity, recently spent a week's furlough as a student in the University of Edinburgh, Scotland.

He took a special course open to United States Army personnel. Outstanding instructors in the university, supplemented by men high in the public service, lectured on government, science, art, religion, education, literature, and international relations.
