

**HEARD ELMER
ERVIN'S VOICE**

July 21, 1943

Word was received Wednesday that William Elmer Ervin was heard on a record over the short wave program from Tokyo, Japan, on Sunday night, July 18. The Japs record the prisoners' voices and send them out over short wave programs.

He stated: "I wish I had some news from home. Try to get me mail at Camp One, South Tokyo, Japan. I am all right and well treated."

A Mrs. Christena Whittier of Santa Monica, California, heard the program and sent the message to his father, Emmitt M. Ervin of Newton vicinity.
