Was Home on Furlough 1943*

Private Robert Fudge, a son of Mrs. Jasper Fudge, formerly of Newton, who was once reported missing in action, has been home on a furlough with his grand-mother, Mrs. David Ridgeway of Newton, who is spending the winter at Danville. He was bayoneted in both ankles and was invalided home.

He participated in five battles and wears the Purple Heart medal and campaign bars with stars. He is returning to the hospital for further treatment.

Bob was born and raised at Newton, residing here until his father's death some years ago.
