"HEIL HITLER" *Sept. 14, 1943*

Mrs. Albert Wilson of Newton has learned that her uncle, William Shannon of Noble, has been discharged from the Army after several months of service. This recalls a story that is related about him while serving at Huntsville, Texas, at a prison camp.

He was marching a group of German prisoners of war out to work and couldn't remember the German word for halt, so he just threw up his arm. The soldiers immediately shot up their arms at a forty-five degree angle in front of them and shouted "Heil Hitler."
