Enclosed in a recent letter to his mother was the menu of his companys Thanksgiving dinner, and it was as much or more than could be expected on the average table back home. Here's what the boys had:

Orange punch, Waldorf salad, cranberry sauce, Roast Turkey with dressing and gravy, french fried potatoes, buttered asparagus, creamed peas, buttered corn, pumpkin pie, cake with buttered cream icing, bread, butter, jam, candy, nuts, tangerines, chocolate milk, coffee.

At the bottom of the menu was a brief message to the boys from Capt. Himer O. E. Johnson, company commander. He said:

"That's all for this year, men. I hope that next Thanksgiving day will find every man in the organization at his mother's or his wife's table, enjoying the extra goodies not available on this menu."
