Phillips, who has been in England with a medical detachment of the United States Army, is now at Billings General hospital, Indianapolis, where he is being given a general examination preliminary to an operation for the removal of a brain tumor. He arrived at the hospital, Sunday, after having been hospitalized in England since January 8.

Mrs. Albert Phillips of Newton and son Dale Phillips of Ann Arbor, Michigan, his mother and brother spent Monday with him. He was glad to be in the United States and said he felt well except for headaches.

Underwent Operation

He underwent an operation in England and the chief surgeon there told him that he had a tumor on his brain, but that it wasn't malginant and would respond to surgery. His right leg has been paralyzed and his activity had been affected.

George is one of four sons and two sons-in-law of Mrs .Phillips in the armed services, and it will soon be five sons, when Dale is called for duty, having been accepted recently at Detroit, Michigan.
