## WOUNDED SOLDIER 3/2 4/44 VISITING HERE

Private Thurman Keeth of Fairfax, Oklahoma, who was wounded in the Sicilian invasion last summer, is visiting his sister, Mrs. Harry Gillespie of Newton. He was wounded in the fighting and is under treatment at O'Reilly General hospital at Springfield, Missouri, and is here on a ten days' furlough.

Private Keeth has undergone nine operations and wears a plate in his skull behind his right ear. He is deaf in that ear now but says he feels good and looks fine.

Another brother of Mrs. Gillespie, Sergeant Lawrence Keeth, who was reported killed in action, is now at Jefferson Barracks near St. Louis.
