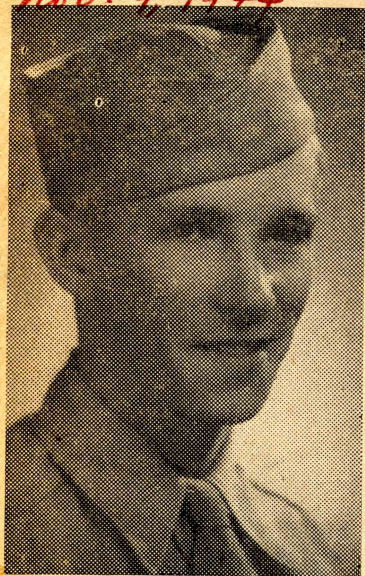


## Dan Diel Stationed On Burma Frontier

NEW DELHI, INDIA: Dan E. Diel, 20 year old son of Mr. and Mrs. James R. Diel of 920 West Washington Street, Newton, has been overseas in the China Burma India Theater of Operations for the past fourteen months.

Technician 5th Grade Diel is a member of the Quartermaster Truck Company of the Services of Supply. His unit is located in Assam, easternmost province of India along the route of supply to our troops in Burma.

Prior to his induction into the Army at Camp Grant, Diel was employed at the Allison Division of the General Motors Corporation in Speedway, Ind. He entered the service about twenty months ago, and received his training at Camp Sutton, N. C. before going overseas.

His brother, Lt. James Lee Diel was killed in Holland during the Airborne invasion of that country by Allied armies.
