T/5 Kenneth Wilson arrived home this week for a thirty-day furlough to be spent with his parents and other Newton relatives, after having spent thirteen months overseas.

"Kenny" is wearing a ribbon with three battle stars earned in the Southern France, Rhineland and Central Europe campaigns the good conduct medal, bronze star and combat infantryman badge.

The bronze star was awarded for action on last New Year's night when he and two comrades, armed with a .50 calibre machine gun, were successful in holding back a German attack while other troops were being withdrawn to safety.
