Two Boys Reported Killed In Action





Parents of two Jasper county boys have been notified by the war department that their sons, previously reported missing in action, are now offical reported as having been killed in action.

One of such messages came to Mr. and Mrs. William Volk telling of the death of their son Urban, who was killed in action in France on January 7, 1945. Before entering the service he was employed at the Parker Cafe in Newton and was widely known here.

The other message came to Mr. and Mrs Charles Rawlings, of Bogota, informing them that their son, corporal John Francis Rawlings, had been killed in action in Italy on April 15.
