Sgt. Gordon Romack is at home for a visit with his parents after having been a patient at Beaumont General Hospital of El Paso, Texas since December 11.

He returned to the states on December 4 after having been a patient in an English hospital since September 25, on which date he was wounded in the fighting in Germany.

He has been decorated with the Purple Heart medal because of the wounds received in combat. His wounds consisted of an injury to one of his eyes and an arm.

After thirty days at home he will return to El Paso for further treatment.
