

NICHOLS BUY

CANTWELL STOCK

WILL TAKE POSSESSION OF SOUTH
SIDE BUSINESS AUGUST 20

Dr. J. E. Cantwell announced yesterday that he had closed a deal whereby his stock of drug sundries and his fountain service on the south side of the square is to pass to the ownership of John E. Nichols, effective August 20.

Dr. Cantwell will continue in the optical business, moving his offices to the second floor of the building he now occupies and will devote his full time to that profession.

Mr. and Mrs. Nichols who for the past year have been operating the Parker Cafe on the north side of the square are closing that business after next Sunday's dinner. They will take a vacation during the time that elapses between next Sunday and the date of their taking possession of their new property.

The building now occupied by the Nichols restaurant will soon be occupied by Mike's Tavern.

This will leave Newton with only three restaurants and it is going to tax them to the limit to be able to cater to the trade that for years has had the choice of four eating places.

But little is known about Nichols' plan for their new business, but it is believed probable that they will some time in the future begin the serving of meals or lunches at their new place.
