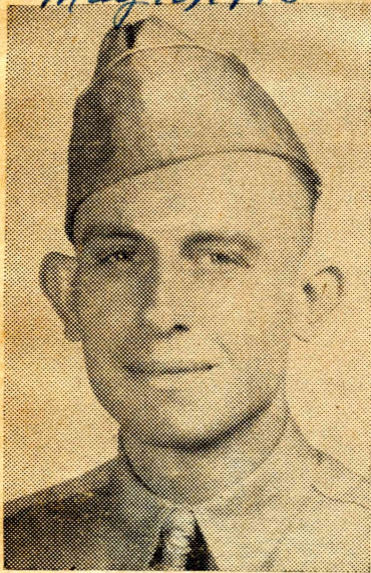


BOGOTA SOLDIER MISSING IN ITALY

May 10, 1945



Mr. and Mrs. Charley Rawlings, residing a mile west of Bogota have received word from the War Department that their son, Corporal John Francis Rawlings, was reported as missing in action in Italy as of April 15.

Corporal Rawlings had been in the service for some three years and had been overseas for two years, serving in the Italian theatre of operations under General Mark Clark in the Fifth Army.

He is 28 years of age and prior to his induction into the service he had been employed by the late Walter Lambird on a farm near Kedron for some ten years.
