

Willow Hill Soldier Is

Freed From Nazi Prison

May 17, 1945

Ernest Eubanks, of Willow Hill, yesterday received a letter from his son, Pfc. Harold Eubanks, who has been held as a prisoner of war by the Germans since December 12.

Young Eubanks' letter was dated May 7. "Don't worry any more," he told his father, "I am free again and no longer a prisoner. I had pancakes and oatmeal for breakfast—all I wanted."

He asked that no more mail be sent to him until further notice and indicated that he expected to get a furlough home within a short time.
