Mr. and Mrs Edward Rentz received a telegram from the War Department April 28th Stating that their son Pfc. Edward W. Rentz, of the United States Infantry, had been slightly wounded on Luzon April 2nd.

No details of his injuries were given. He has been in the Service three years this coming October and has been overseas twenty-two months. He was in New Guinea, but a short time ago was moved to the Philippines. He received the Infantry Combat Badge, six months ago and has had no furlough since being in the Service
