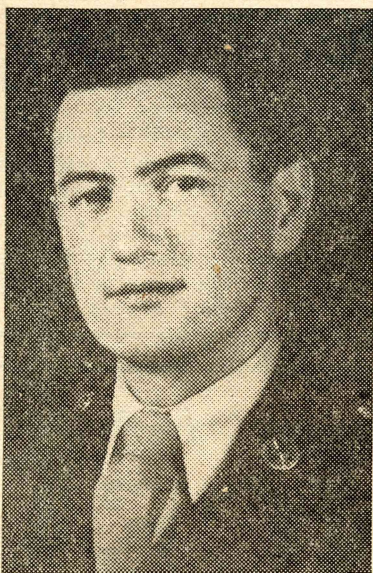




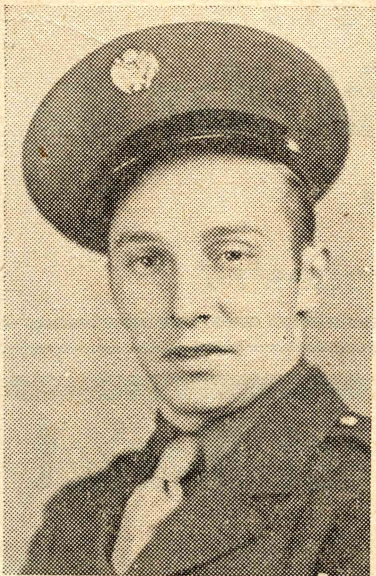
With the Colors
